Format

Teams of four players (male, female or mixed) playing an 18-hole Stableford Competition, with the best two of the team's net points to count at each hole.

Full handicap allowances, subject to a limit of 24 for men and 36 for ladies.

The Prize-giving will follow the handing in of the last cards.

Conditions of Entry

Entry will be in teams of four players, one of whom is nominated as Captain. Each player must have a current playing handicap certificate issued by a recognised Golf Club. The entry fee is £30 per player (£120.00 per team, to include meal), and must accompany the completed official entry form.

Juniors (under 18 years) are welcome but are restricted to two (2) per team of four players.

(The meal will consist of a Bacon Sandwich, Tea or Coffee on arrival and an All Day Carvery on completion of your round, (a vegetarian option is available, please discuss with the Chef)).

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Conditions of Competition

Teams of four will play from the first tee at times laid down in the starting sheet. Gentlemen will play from the "yellow" tee markers, ladies from the "red" ones. Teams will use the special scorecards and stroke index prepared for the event. The Rules of Golf for Stableford stroke-play will apply, together with the Club's Local Rules. Any rulings that may be required will be given by the nominated Competition Referee. The stableford competition will be played from full handicap, limited for gentlemen to 24, and for ladies to 36. Team Captains are responsible for ensuring that every player in his/her team has a current handicap certificate issued by a recognised Golf Club, or, in the absence of such certificate, for requesting that the player be allocated an appropriate handicap by the Competition Committee.

Juniors (under 18 years) are welcome but are restricted to two (2) per team of four players.

The team's score for each hole will be the sum of the best two net Stableford points scored at that hole. The Captain of the team will record for each hole in the appropriate columns on the scorecard the relevant gross and nett scores, and the resulting team's points score. The completed card will be signed by the Captain and one other team member, and handed in as soon as possible after completion of the round.

In the event of a tie, the winning score will be decided on the better points score on the last nine holes, or the last six, or the last three, as appropriate. If there is still a tie, the result will be decided on the last twelve, or the last fifteen holes.
